Help End Hunger - Rain, Snow or Shine Event

Glen Burnie UMC Missions invites all ages to help feed the needy families in our community and region. On Sat., Feb 25th, 9 am Glen Burnie UMC Missions will partner with the Society of St. Andrew and the Annapolis District United Methodist Men to distribute 45,000 pounds of fresh Maine Potatoes.

We need volunteers of all ages to repackage 250 50-lb bags to 10-lb bags and distribute them to Senior Apartments and needy families in Glen Burnie and Severn. Each 10-lb bag will include an invitation to join our church, if they do not have a church family. Additionally, church and foodbank organizations are invited to reserve as many of the remaining 650 bags for their own distribution.

We have asked the Glen Burnie High School Football team to help with unloading the 850 50-lb bags of potatoes. The Glen Burnie United Methodist Men will provide coffee, tea, juice, and donuts for all volunteers at 8:30 am.
