The Anne Arundel County Board of Elections would like to ask members of your Adult and Young Adult fellowship ministries/groups to serve as Election Judges for the 2024 Presidential Election Cycle.

An Election Judge can be as young as sixteen years old; an opportunity for high school students to earn service-learning credits and a chance for all to serve and observe democracy in action through the election process. This is a great opportunity for your church members/groups to work together and in fellowship with their communities. The Anne Arundel County Board of Elections values the opportunity to work with your members to ensure the success of the 2024 Presidential Election Cycle.

All Election Judges receive pay for attending mandatory training, pre-election setup, and working on Election Day. We will work with all volunteers or groups to make sure they are in a location close to home. If a volunteer requests a specific location, we work to see if that is possible. There are even opportunities for those interested in working during early voting and pre- or post-election ballot canvassing.
