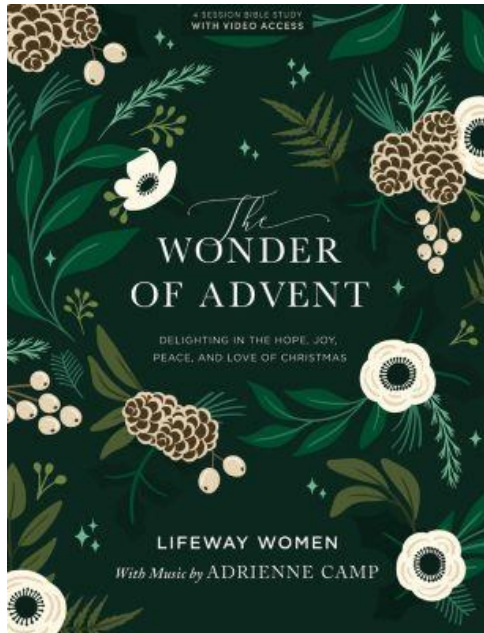

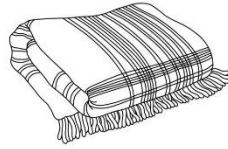


Advent Bible Study
