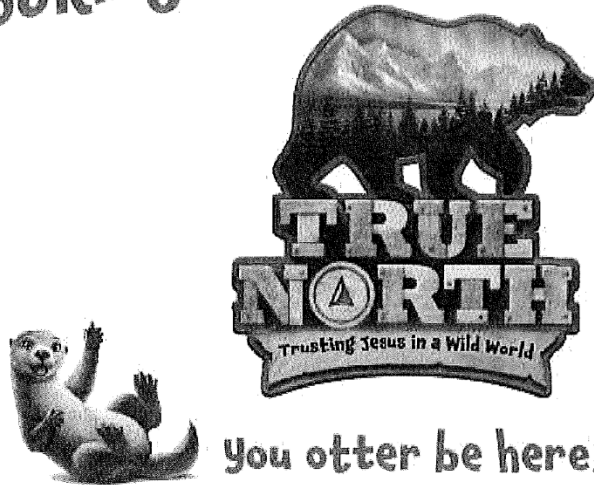
Volunteers Needed

Scholarships

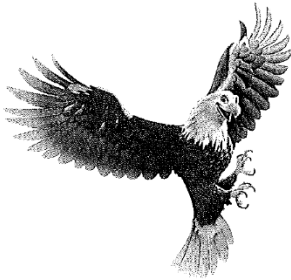
